- Understanding when and why we have a restricted burning period
- What it means to have a permit to burn
- Is my property prepared for the current season, what else can I do?
- How to plan for 2008/2009 summer
- What it means to be a volunteer fire fighter
- How do I join the brigade?
- How can I help if I don't want to be a fire fighter?

Whether you are a long term resident/landowner or new to Gidgegannup this meeting will cover the things that you can, should and must do to protect yourselves and your homes in the event of a fire emergency in Gidgegannup.
