The Inaugural “*Countryman Gidgegannup Small Farm Field Day*” is going to be held at the Gidgegannup Showgrounds on Sunday 29th of June 2008. Gidgegannup is located in the Perth Hills, 15 minutes from Midland along the Toodyay Rd.

The field day is being organised by Experience Gidgegannup with sponsorship from the Countryman, EMRC, City of Swan, Port Bouvard Ltd and the Dept of Agriculture and Food.

The event promises to be a day packed full of a diverse range of information and advice on all aspects of a small farm, the opportunity to visit open farms, animal shows and sale plus the latest product and equipment demonstrations.

A shuttle bus service will run all day taking visitors to open farms where they can participate in a field visit and talks from guest speakers on a range of subjects. The EMRC have sponsored a mulch trial at one of the open farms with a range of other activities also which will be valuable information for visitors who don't necessarily have acreage.

Allot of the displays will be small farm related but there will be entertainment including fashion parades, and other attractions to suit people from all walks of life and ages.

A bus service will run in the morning from the Midland train station to the showgrounds, and return in the afternoon to the Midland station. Gates open at 9am – 5pm , Over 5 years \$5 entry.
