The pony club raised money to build a cross country course on land owned by the main roads department adjacent to our grounds. Our CNC attracts 250 riders from all over the state who will compete in 12 classes from pcawa E grade at 45cm to CNC at 115cm.**

All classes will ride a dressage test on Saturday with some classes also completing a show jumping round. Sunday will see all classes completing their cross country round and finishing the show jumping.

Presentations should begin around 3.30 on Sunday.
