

## GIDGEGANNUP TOWNSITE DEVELOPMENT

Port Bouvard in a recent newsletter have announced that several Planning Workshops will be held in April.

Invitations will be sent in the first instance to Port Bouvard database members and numbers will be restricted to 40 participants per workshop.

The intent of these workshop sessions is to seek feedback about how the town/village may appear, as well as guiding principles for the development of its overall design.

Given that our Place Planning Workshops were attended by several hundred members of the community and that at a meeting in October 2006 over 300 members of the community turned up at a Planning Meeting, and that over 100 attended a meeting in November 2007 on the same subject, places will fill fast.

These workshops are a critical opportunity for the community to truly have their say in the future of the township. It is stated that "Every resident and ratepayer is entitled to attend the workshop" in the newsletter.
