## COMMUNITY GRANTS

city of swan



Since 2008, the Woolworths Fresh Food Kids Community Grants program has helped fund grassroots initiatives to improve the health and wellbeing of primary school aged kids across the country. This year, a total of \$3 million is available and your organisation could be awarded a grant of up to \$5,000 to help fund your project.

### To be eligible:

#### Your initiative must:

1. be designed for primary school aged children
2. encourage kids to lead healthier, more active lives
3. take place outside of the school curriculum

#### Your organisation must:

1. be a not-for-profit organisation
2. have an ABN or be affiliated with a not-for-profit organisation that has an ABN (for example a school, or governing body – Scouts Australia or the Department of Education.)

#### You must:

1. hold an official position within your organisation (i.e. School Principal, Club President, parents and supporters **cannot** apply)

Please note the result of your grant application will be announced, and grant monies awarded, in July-August 2010.

## Leadership grant helps female sports administrator excel

The 2010–11 Sport Leadership Grants and Scholarships for Women (SLGSfW) are now open for applications. Women from all areas and levels are encouraged to apply for funding to pursue accredited training and development to assist them in gaining leadership positions in the sporting industry. Rachael Roberts, General Manager of Swimming Australia's Commercial and Communications section, is a 2009–10 SLGSfW grant recipient. She saw the grants as an opportunity to pursue her career ambition of sitting on the board of an organisation and used her funding to complete an intensive Australian Institute of Company Directors course.

Roberts gives the SLGSfW program high praise, crediting it with helping her take a major step towards becoming a leader in her field.

'I have to say that gaining the grant was what drove me the most,' Roberts said. 'Being able to do the course has reinforced to me the serious commitment a director has to make. It requires as much dedication as any full-time job.'

Now in its ninth year, the Australian Government grants have helped more than 16 500 women reach their potential in all areas of sport from managers, administrators, media and communication officers to coaches, officials and women in sport governance.

## 2010 CITY OF BAYSWATER SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES



### LOCAL SPORT REPRESENTATION SCHOLARSHIP



Three (3) Scholarships of \$500 each, payable in one (1) instalment to assist individuals to attain excellence in their chosen sport.

**Applicants must reside in the City of Bayswater as at 7 May 2010 and be at least 12 years of age. Where however, an applicant is under the age of 12 but participates in a sport where athletes typically reach their prime under or around the age of 12, Council may at its discretion, accept an application.**

### SPORT AND SPORTING OFFICIAL

Two (2) Scholarships of \$1,200 each, payable in four (4) instalments over two (2) years, are awarded annually to assist individuals attain excellence in their chosen sport.  
1 Scholarship of \$1,200, payable in four (4) instalments over two (2) years, will be awarded annually to assist an individual progress their involvement, training and development as a Sports Official.

**Applicants must reside in the City of Bayswater as at 7 May 2010 and be at least 16 years of age. Where however, an applicant is under the age of 16 but participates in a sport where athletes typically reach their prime under or around the age of 16, Council may at its discretion, accept an application.**

Persons currently in receipt of a City of Bayswater Scholarship in Education, Visual Art, Sport, Music or Dance are not eligible to apply.

Nominations should be submitted from either the Club President or School Head Teacher that provide written justification outlining how financial pressure is a barrier to the applicant participating in a local sporting competition. The Selection Committee appointed by the City of Bayswater will award scholarships using this information as well as the following criteria:

- Personal History
- Character Conduct
- Proven Sporting Ability or Demonstrated Sporting Official Involvement
- Specified Sporting Objectives
- Satisfactory Progress and Endeavour

Decisions made by the appointed Selection Committee will be final and no further communication will be entered into.

***Applications close on Friday, 7 May 2010. Interviews will be held on Wednesday, 26 May 2010 and applicants will be notified by mail of their scheduled interview time.***
