QUIT Targa West Update: 7th – 10th September 2006

With just three months until the second running of WA's own 'Targa' style rally, plans are now well advanced to make this a real community event within the Gidgegannup area.

The rally runs for 4 days from the 7th of June through to the 10th and will be in Gidgegannup on Friday the 8th. The organizers will be using the Gidgegannup Sports Oval as a 'Service Park' on the day where the cars and teams will be stopping to work on their vehicles; take on board refreshments as well as providing spectators with an opportunity to get up close to the action as they mingle amongst the cars and drivers.

With nearly all of the 80 available entries now filled there will be a wide and interesting array of vehicles including cars from Ford, Holden, Porsche, Lamborghini, Mitsubishi, Subaru, BMW, Maserati and more.

The event attracted huge interest last year and will be a terrific addition to the Gidgegannup tourism calendar as well as generating significant press and TV coverage for the area.

Key Times that residents need to be aware of in respect of the rally are that there will be road closures from 9.45am through to 1.45pm on Friday the 8th of September on sections of O'Brien Road and all of Clenton Road (the rally runs from West to East with the road closure starting 500metres north of Lot 125 on O'Brien Rd and finishes at the corner of Clenton and Berry Road.)

The rally itself will run along these closed roads from 10.20am through to 1.20pm and they will be going into the Gidgegannup Oval twice for 30 minutes each time. This will effectively mean that there will be non-stop action at the Oval from 11.00am through to 2.00pm.
